The objectives of the Act are sought to be achieved through the Competition Commission of India, which has been established by the Central Government with effect from 14th October 2003. CCI consists of a Chairperson and 6 Members appointed by the Central Government. It is the duty of the Commission to eliminate practices having adverse effect on competition, promote and sustain competition, protect the interests of consumers and ensure freedom of trade in the markets of India. The Commission is also required to give opinion on competition issues on a reference received from a statutory authority established under any law and to undertake competition advocacy, create public awareness and impart training on competition issues.

ABOUT THE CONFERENCE

Interplay between the competition and corporate law is inevitable. The corporate management and market are very dynamic as a result Competition and Corporate law are ever growing subject. Company law on the one hand, regulating the internal and external *feasance* of a company, competition law on the other hand, regulating the market behaviours of the company.
